13	rules regulating the public utility systems within the Lewes BPW Service Area, and the tapping

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16	WHEREAS, Section 4.20 of the Lewes BPW Charter authorizes the Lewes BPW to supply
17	utility systems to those properties located within two (2) miles of the corporate limits of the City
18	of Lewes, as presently constituted or as may be extended, and is further authorized to enact and
19	adopt rules and regulations that the Lewes BPW deems proper in order to supply said utility
20	services; and
21 22	WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Lewes BPW (the "Board of Directors") deems
23	it in the best interests of the Lewes BPW utility system and customers, both current and future, to
24	extend the Lewes BPW Service Area for water utility operations to include that certain property
25	in unincorporated Sussex County, being further identified by Sussex County Tax Parcel ID
26	Numbers 335-8.00-2.00 and 335-8.00-2.02 (the "Property") in connection with the Tower Hill
27	development project (the "Project"); and

29	WHEREAS, the Lewes BPW and CMF Tower Hill, LLC, the owner and developer of the
30	Property, by that certain Tower Hill Development Agreement, dated September 24, 2020 and
31	recorded October 7, 2020 in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Sussex County, agreed
32	to extend the Lewes BPW Service Area for water utility operations to include the Property; and
